**** IMPORTANT!! PLEASE READ ****

We must have an import permit for your order if your country requires it. If you cannot include the import permit with your order, it must arrive two weeks prior to your shipping date. We cannot ship your order without one. If your country requires barerooting and you do not wish to have your plants barerooted, you must send an official letter from your Dept. of Agriculture waiving this requirement. The United States Dept. of Agriculture will not authorize shipment otherwise. Canadians must contact the Canadian Dept. of Agriculture to pay for import permit and inspection fees before shipment. Canadian shipments cannot leave customs until payment is made. If you have any questions, please e-mail/write, call, or fax our office.

Shipping Information

Please Read Carefully!

Please Note: All shipping priced provided are estimates. Cost may be higher or lower depending on weight, plant size and other factors.

Shipping:

We will ship your plants by United Parcel Service ground shipping to any state west of the Mississippi. East of that mark it is best to use UPS 2nd day air or 3 day select service. UPS has proven to be the best and most cost effective way to ship your plants. The fee schedule on your order form is designed to give you an idea of what the cost will be, the actual cost of shipping will be included on your invoice.

If you choose ground shipping East of the Mississippi, be aware that your plants may be in transit for over a week and will be subject to stress which may result in loss. We cannot be responsible for damage, delay or loss as a result of shipping. All orders become the property of the purchaser upon delivery to the transportation company.

International Shipping:

Unfortunately, shipping plants internationally is very expensive and subject to a variety of restrictions and governmental requirements for the country they are being shipped to. All shipments outside the U.S. require a phytosanitary certificate and inspection by the Washington State Dept. of Agriculture. Many countries require the purchaser to have an import permit and possibly other paperwork requirements. We must fulfill all of the requirements of your government at least a week prior to the shipping date you have chosen. You are responsible for knowing the regulations for shipping plants into your country, we will help every way we can.

The most cost effective way we have found to ship internationally is US Express mail and we have included a guide for approximating cost on your order form. We can also ship your plants via Pilot Airfreight. This method works well but is very expensive, up to 100% of the cost of your plant order. If you require this method we will fax or e-mail an estimate of shipping cost approximately 2 weeks prior to shipping for your approval. International shipping will be invoiced separately from your plant order.

Packing:

We make every effort to insure your plants arrive in good condition. We use three standard box sizes and shredded paper for packing material. Most plants are stripped of containers and loose soil, then wrapped in plastic and newsprint. The epiphytes however, are left in containers as their root systems are more easily damaged. All orders are assembled, checked and prepared for packing by our loyal band of volunteers. Without them we could not get these wonderful species rhododendrons to your garden.
