

Important Parking Information

Classes offered: Standard and FAST. One course will be set in each ring. You may run the numbered course or your own pattern. No scoring or prizes will be offered. Walk through will begin as soon as the course is set, approximately 2:00 pm. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs must be a minimum of 1 year in age. Any AKC eligible dog may enter. Dogs do not need to be entered in the regular trials. Dogs may be entered multiple times in the same class with a maximum of 4 runs per dog. Event is limited to 400 runs. Each run will be a maximum of 60 seconds.

Toys and clickers are allowed in the ring. Food is not allowed in the ring. Maximum course time will be strictly enforced. No harsh verbal or physical corrections allowed. Excusal for dog fouling the ring.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- 50% refund for bitches in season after the closing date and up to the Friday before the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No refund for duplicate entry or entry in class that is not offered i.e. FAST or T2B on days not offered.
- Withdrawal of entry before closing date will receive refund less \$6 processing fee.
- Refunds are mailed in the time frame of seven days before to seven days after the event.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Failure to follow the instructions of the Show Committee or their Agent will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard, FAST and JWW. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard, FAST and JWW. Regular and Preferred Titling for Time 2 Beat. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste. 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-2028. To Place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Course Familiarization / Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day to day move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded to Excellent B dogs earning a Double Q while supply lasts after which QQ pins will be offered. QQQ Pins will be awarded to Excellent B dogs earning a Triple Q. QQQQ Pins will be awarded to Excellent B dogs earning four Q in the same day. Rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing a title. Special rosette awarded to any dog earning the MACH or PACH title. Each dog entered will receive a toy at check in. One toy per dog per weekend.

Wait List: Lost Coast KC offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 pm on July 5, 2012. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on July 16, 2012 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a refund will be issued and mailed in the time frame of 7 days before to 7 days following the event. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on July 16, 2012 will receive a FULL REFUND.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim or loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing the at of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near nay entrance thereto, and I 9we0 personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sold responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or an y other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSLEF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height divisions.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
